INTRODUCTION

The Waterberg Council Chamber is a place where the Executive Mayor and her council hold their important meetings and official events. The council chamber is sometimes used by WDM officials for their meetings, workshops and/or training sessions with external stakeholders or service providers. This place therefore has to look fabulous and attractive at all times to enhance the image of the municipality.

BACKGROUND

The carpet in WDM Council Chamber has been installed more than 20 years back when the council chamber was built. The carpet now looks old, dirty and stained even after thorough washing or cleaning. This old carpet needs to be removed and replaced with new one so that the place can look decent, beautiful and attractive, and also be a conducive environment for both councillors and officials to hold their meetings.

Carpet tiles

Area: 200m^2

DECLARATION CERTIFICATE FOR LOCAL PRODUCTION AND CONTENT

This Municipal Bidding Document (MBD) must form part of all bids invited. It contains general information and serves as a declaration form for local content (local production and local content are used interchangeably).

Before completing this declaration, bidders must study the General Conditions, Definitions, Directives applicable in respect of Local Content as prescribed in the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2011 and the South African Bureau of Standards (SABS) approved technical specification number SATS 1286:201x.

1. General Conditions

- 1.1. Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2011 (Regulation 9.(1) and 9.(3) make provision for the promotion of local production and content.
- 1.2. Regulation 9.(1) prescribes that in the case of designated sectors, where in the award of bids local production and content is of critical importance, such bids must be advertised with the specific bidding condition that only locally produced goods, services or works or locally manufactured goods, with a stipulated minimum threshold for local production and content will be considered.
- 1.3. Regulation 9.(3) prescribes that where there is no designated sector, a specific bidding condition may be included, that only locally produced services, works or goods or locally manufactured goods with a stipulated minimum threshold for local production and content, will be considered.
- 1.4. Where necessary, for bids referred to in paragraphs 1.2 and 1.3 above, a two stage bidding process may be followed, where the first stage involves a minimum threshold for local production and content and the second stage price and B-BBEE.
