



CALL FOR PROPOSALS
“UPGRADING AND REFURBISHMENT OF EXISTING WDM MODIMOLLE
ABATTOIR PROJECT”

Waterberg District Municipality (WDM) invites service providers to submit proposals for the Upgrading and refurbishment of the existing Modimolle Abattoir project in Limpopo Province as described in the Terms of Reference (TOR) document. Tenderers to be specialists in the construction and refurbishment of red meat abattoirs and must be registered with the CIDB. Service Providers must familiarize themselves with the WDM abattoir, municipality's processes, meat safety act and the WDM policies and take them into account when preparing their proposal.

The scope of work of the project includes refurbishment of abattoir building, lairages, equipment, refrigeration plant, accessories and upgrading the status quo to comply with the meat safety act (Act 40 of 2000).

Tender documents are available and can be obtained at non-refundable amount of R200.00 from the Municipality's offices. Interested Service Providers must attend a compulsory briefing session on the 18/07/08 at 10h00 in the Municipality's Abattoir located at corner Oktaan and Thabo Mbeki streets in Modimolle. All proposals must be in a sealed envelope and marked **“Upgrading and refurbishment of the existing Modimolle Abattoir”** and be deposited in the tender box of WDM Council Building, Harry Gwala Street, Modimolle. The closing date for submission is the 01 August 2008 @ 16:00.

Proposals will be evaluated on the basis of the PPPFA 90/10 point system, and WDM Supply Chain Management Policy. No fax or email proposals will be accepted.
